Program Description

The Peel Community Participation program provides supports to people with a range of interests and support needs. This program offers a wide variety of activities that can be tailored to individual's capabilities. For example, activities are offered in different ways to accommodate varying levels of participation and ability. This location is wheelchair accessible, but does not have ceiling lifts to provide supports to people who are unable to pivot or assist with transferring.

Activities

Recreational activities include:

- physical activities in the on-site gym
- art therapy
- music appreciation
- swimming at local community centre
- adapted gardening

- trips to local events and attractions such as Butterfly Conservatory, Downey's Farm, Niagara Falls, local theatre productions
- accessible boating
