## Program Description

The Waterloo Community Participation Program provides both community and location based activity opportunities to adults who have a developmental disability in the Kitchener, Cambridge and Waterloo area. Our program's mission is "fulfilling dreams, achieving goals and going beyond the ordinary."

## Activities

Waterloo Community Participation Program creates person-specific schedules based on personal goals, supports needed and available funding.

- An emphasis is placed on community involvement, such as watching movies at local theaters, going to the library, walking community trails, visiting conservation areas, and stopping by the St. Jacob's market.
- Learning opportunities to gain skills include sign language, Spanish lessons, cooking, and money management.
- Recreational activities include bowling, swimming, drumming, music time, and Zumba.
- Trips to attractions such as Medieval times, CNE, etc..
- Other options include employment/volunteer opportunities with Mennonite Central Committee, Conestoga College, Meals on Wheel's, and the local Humane Society.
