*week two:*

## March 7-13

**THOUGHT** We may be hurting, afraid, lonely, or tired of physical distancing in this pandemic Lenten season. Jesus also experienced these feelings as he went to the cross for us. He *chose* to endure all those painful things so that people could be saved: That is how much Jesus loves us!

### PRAYER POINTS

- In coordination with people who use Christian Horizons services, their families and MCCSS, the North District is working towards opening a space on the lower level of a home to be used as an apartment for people living on their own. Praise God for making this collaboration possible. Pray for a good match as vacancies are made available and for God's blessing on this exciting initiative!

- Pray for peace and stability in Ethiopia and Haiti.

*week three:*

## March 14 -20

"...They live by the truth with God's help. They come into the light so that it will be easy to see their good deeds."

**THOUGHT:** This verse offers a description of people who are faithful to God. We do not feel the need to hide our actions, nor do we seek credit for ourselves. We can let people see what we are doing in the name of Jesus and give him all the glory.

### PRAYER POINTS

- Pray for the Church network that Christian Horizons Global works through in Kenya: They continue to look for ways to remove barriers for people with disabilities in their congregations and communities.
- Praise the Lord for the protection from COVID outbreaks in all the communities in North District.
- Pray for all who are struggling with mental health at this time, especially since it may be exacerbated by the shorter days of winter and pandemic related restrictions.
- Thank God for social media and innovative ways for people to connect with family and friends throughout the pandemic and beyond: Some employees have come alongside people who use Christian Horizons services to create their own Facebook accounts.

*week four:*

## March 21-27

"My soul is troubled. What should I say? 'Father, keep me from having to go through with this'? No. This is the very reason I have come to this point in my life. Father, bring glory to your name!" Jesus, *Jn 12:27-28 NIRV*

**THOUGHT:** The Bible verses above include a prayer that Jesus prayed the night before he faced death on the cross for all people, past, present, and future. We can use it as an example of what to pray whenever our souls are troubled if we face something difficult or painful.

### PRAYER POINTS

- Pray for district leaders who are managing shifting needs that occur when schedule changes happen. This is especially complex as COVID-19 safety guidelines are constantly changing.
- Give thanks for the many ways that employees and people who use Christian Horizons services are staying grounded together in simple practical ways of making each day enjoyable.
- Pray that God would give strength to host family providers. Pray that God would equip other host family respite providers to come alongside them.
- Christian Horizons continues to advocate for the availability and priority of vaccines of people who use services and employees who support them. Pray that this advocacy is fruitful.
